The DBQ involved analyzing a set of historical documents and constructing a coherent essay that integrated the documents with outside knowledge. This section assessed students' skills in sourcing, contextualization, and argumentation.

## Long Essay Question (LEQ)

The LEQ required students to write a detailed essay on a chosen historical theme or development, demonstrating depth of understanding and effective argument construction.

Short-answer responses were similarly graded based on accuracy, completeness, and historical evidence.

For the first time, the exam was taken online at home. This transition required students to have reliable internet access and manage exam conditions independently. The College Board provided guidelines to maintain academic integrity.

## **Content Reduction**

The College Board limited the scope of the curriculum to ease the burden of remote instruction and learning disruptions. This meant earlier historical periods were not tested, allowing students and teachers to focus on recent historical developments.

While some challenges arose due to the new format and remote testing environment, many students adapted successfully. Educators emphasized flexibility and support to help students navigate the changes effectively.
